

WHAT MAKES OUR DONORS GREAT



We are incredibly selective with our egg and sperm donors. We eject over 70% of applicates based on their applications alone. We seek to attract bright, healthy young women intent on creating a win-win situation where the generous act of providing eggs to intended parents is rewarded with compensation that will make a difference.

All our donors must meet the requirements for egg donors by law by the Ministry of Health of Ukraine as well as our additional stringent standards.

Egg donors in our program must:

- Have at least one healthy child born naturally
- Be between 20 and 32 years old
- Have no criminal record
- Have no family history of poor health, disease or disorders
- Not smoke, drink or use drugs
- Have no exposure to chemicals or other dangers

Our donors undergo rigorous testing before they are offered to you. Egg donors can only enter our program only after passing these tests:

- Full bloodwork and urine analysis
- Karyotype
- Fragile X
- Coagulogram
- Txoplasmosis, rubella
- Hepatitis B and C
- PAP Smear and cytological test
- AMH, LH, Estradiol

- Psychological test
- Cystic fibrosis
- Biochemical blood test,
- Chlamydia, ureaplasma, micoplasma
- HIV, AIDS
- Syphilis
- Ovary ultrasound
- RH factor

Egg donors in Ukraine by law must be anonymous. We share information to you within that restriction. This includes: photos, hair and eye color, weight and height, education level, hobbies etc.



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Obligatory analyses for Egg Donors

- Blood type and Rh
- Syphilis (IgM+IgG)
- HIV ½(antibodies) + ½ (antigen) HIV Ag/Ab COM-BO
- HBsAg (antigen HBs)
- Hbcor Ag (Anti Hbcor)
- Anti-HCV-total (antibodies to antigens of virus Hepatitis C)
- Karyotype
- DNA-diagnostics of cystic fibrosis (21 mutated + polymorphism IVS8-nT)
- DNA-diagnostics of Martin-Bell syndrome (fragile X)
- DNA-diagnostics of spinal muscular atrophy
- DNA-diagnostics of Sensorineural Hearing Loss (SNHL)
- DNA-diagnostics of phenylketonuria
- Antibodies to cytomegalovirus IgM
- Antibodies to cytomegalovirus IgG
- Antibodies to herpes virus type 1/2 IgM
- Antibodies to herpes virus type 1 IgG
- Antibodies to herpes virus type 2 IgG
- Polymerase chain reaction (PCR). DNA diagnostics for Chlamydia trachomatis (scraping, urine, qualitative research), code 72
- Polymerase chain reaction (PCR). DNA diagnostics for Mykoplasma hominis (scraping, urine, qualitative research), code 74





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Continuation of Obligatory analyses for Egg Donors

- Polymerase chain reaction (PCR). DNA diagnostics for Ureaplasma species (scraping, urine, qualitative research), code 73
- Anti-Müllerian hormone (AMH)
- General Blood Analysis (automatic hemisphere analyzer: 31 indicators)
- Coagulogram on automatic analyzer (prothrombin according to Quick (Hepato Quick), prothrombin time (PT), MHB (INR), fibrinogen, activated partial thromboplastin time APTT)
- Microscopy of urogenital secretions, code 16
- PAP test by liquid cytology method (SurePath BD).

- Documents filled in according to Decree by Ministry of Health of Ukraine #787
- Medical report by general practitioner
- Medical report by psychiatrist
